NAPTON SHOW CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Condition 1.** The right is reserved to refuse any entry, cancel or to alter the programme.
- Condition 2.** The Judge's decision will be accepted as absolutely **FINAL** for the results of **ALL EVENTS**.
- Condition 3.** The Committee will not be held responsible for any accident to competitors, horses, spectators or vehicles or any other property on the showground.
- Condition 4.** No receipt for entries will be sent. Should Exhibitors wish to receive their numbers before the Show Day, a large stamped addressed envelope must be enclosed with the entries.
- Condition 5.** No entries by telephone or fax.
- Condition 6.** Any person riding on the show ground to wear a hard hat and correct riding boots.
- Condition 7.** No motorised bicycles or quad bikes to be ridden on the show ground except by officials.
- Condition 8.** Handlers of colts/stallions must be 12 years and over.
- Condition 9.** For showing in hand classes all handlers 16yrs and under **MUST** wear hard hats. All other handlers to be appropriately dressed.

THE SIDE SADDLE ASSOCIATION

Class 10

The Side Saddle Association Equitation Championships Open Qualifying Class

Run under S.S.A. Rules defined in the current Members Handbook. Open to SSA Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship Points. **Southernden Farm** offers a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. **Side Saddle International** offer a rosette to the Adult Member and **Manor Grange Stud Show Centre** to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out. Juniors must wear Hats to current Safety Standard or above.

Class 11

Side Saddle Concours d'Élégance

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. 4 Special rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Adult Members wearing a silk hat, bowler hat, safety hat and the highest placed Junior Member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. **N.B.** Silk hats are permitted to be worn by Adults IN THIS CLASS AT ANY TIME OF DAY. Juniors **must** wear hats to current British Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

Class 12

Best Horse or Pony Ridden Side Saddle (New for 2017)**

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over: confirmation & manners will be taken in to consideration; horses/ponies will not be stripped. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards.

**The Highest placed coloured exhibit (who has not already qualified) receives a Special Rosette and qualifies for the Side Saddle Final at the CHAPS Championship Show. Open to any type of exhibit. Riders must be 16 or over. Riders/Owners need not be a member or their exhibit registered with CHAPS at the time of qualification, but in order to compete at the Championships, the Rider/Owner must be a showing member and their horse/pony registered with CHAPS before entering the final.

Side Saddle Association cont'd...

Class 13

Side Saddle COSTUME Concours d'Élégance

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse/pony and rider, and the way of going of the horse/pony. Safe tack must be used. Detailed inspection of the rider's period costume is not required. Fancy dress is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the judge may ask small groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. 2 Special rosettes to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card. Competitors should produce a brief résumé about their costumes for the commentator. Juniors **must** wear hats to current British Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

EQUIFEST QUALIFIERS 2017

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on 9th – 13th August 2017

EQ next to the class name within the schedule denotes Equifest Qualifier

Classes 1, 2, 3 & 4 - KBIS / EQUIFEST WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Working Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride.

Class 5 – THE STOKES FAMILY / OPEN WORKING HUNTER

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Riders of stallions to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 1.14m (3'9") at the discretion of the judge.

Class 22 - MISS JO BREW / EQUIFEST OPEN SMALL HUNTERS

Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

Class 24 – BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided

Class 25 - NUPAFEEED / EQUIFEST RIDING HORSES

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age. Classes may be divided

Class 31 – CARVERNOMA ALLIANCE UK / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Classes 32a & 32b – SPILLERS / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

This class may be divided as appropriate.

Classes 30, 33a & 33b - THE HEWITT FAMILY/ EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

This class may be divided as appropriate.

Equifest Qualifiers cont'd...

Class 38 - NUPAFEEED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as appropriate

Class 58 - BSPA / EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions

Classes may be divided according to entries.

Class 60 - BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions.

Classes may be divided according to entries
